Mrs Heather Rowell from the Isle of Wight Council's Public Health department and Jenny Boulton, newly appointed Local Area Coordinator for the Ventnor area, attended the meeting to introduce and explain the Local Area Coordinator's role. Councillors advised on how best to develop links with the local community including meeting with Chale Village Partnership and attending Chale Day.

Cllr Ron Groves opened the meeting by thanking Cllr Liam Cumming for his years of chairmanship and for his continued support as Councillor.

#### 241/16 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

Following the meeting held 9<sup>th</sup> May, IWC Cllr Dave Stewart has agreed to represent the Community Bus Partnership on behalf of Chale Parish Council. Bags for the Litter Pick have been delivered to the Halls ahead of the Litter Pick and arrangements have been made for them to be picked up from the Green on 11<sup>th</sup> July.

#### 242/16 FIRST RESPONDER SCHEME

Apologies had been received from Dominique Howard, Lead for Community Response due to ill health. This item will be deferred to a later date when Dominique can attend.

#### 243/16 MOBILE RECYCLING UNIT

This item was brought forward to the start of the meeting following on from the presentation by Heather Rowell and Jenny Boulton.

Paul Southall and Simon Butler from Amey attended the meeting to update the PC on the new mobile recycling unit which will be visiting Whale Chine car park twice a month. Days will be rotated across the Island to include Saturdays with approximate times of 10.00 – 4.00pm, however this will be reviewed and extended depending on demand, particularly in the summer. More information about what can be recycled will be advertised online and via press releases nearer the time. Cllrs suggested the Chale Mail would be a good way to update the local community. Paul and Simon advised Amey has an education trailer which they would like to bring along to events such as Chale Day and the Chale Show to promote recycling and answer any questions from the public. Cllr Bernasconi and Paragreen provided

their contacts for Chale Day and Cllr Ron Groves agreed to provide them with contacts for the Chale Show to take this forward. They also informed the PC about a monthly community forum for issues to be raised, next meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> June 3-5pm at the Bargemans Rest which a PC representative would be welcomed to. They also have staff volunteers available for litter pick events and it was suggested that they might be able to come and help clear the brambles on the Green after the nesting season.

It was agreed to continue with the current provision via the Isle of Wight Council as it provides the best value for money.

#### 248/16 THE AMMONITE BENCH AND OTHER SEATS ON THE CHALE TRAIL

1 To reach agreement over who will be the custodian of the new ammonite bench which replaced the old bench opposite the church

The Clerk explained that this item had been raised by Island Roads who had previously maintained the seat which has now been replaced by the ammonite bench on the Chale Trail

The Parish Council will take over the custodianship of the ammonite bench.

The Parish Council will take custodianship of all the new seats on the Chale Trail with the exception of the seat on St. Catherine's Down which is on National Trust land.

#### 251/16 TO RECEIVE REPORTS FROM:

- 1. The Clerk with any correspondence received
  - A meeting with Southern Vectis to discuss the number 6 winter bus service is being organised with Chale, Niton and Whitwell and Chillerton and Gatcombe PCs this coming Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2016 Cllr Cumming is attending and will report back.
  - Training opportunity organised through IWALC Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2016 £50 per delegate or free by subscribing to IWALC's annual membership for £105.86. On reflection Cllrs feel they do not require any further training
  - Request from Sustainable Chale regarding the PC applying for planning permission on their behalf for the bike station they are hoping to base at the shop. If the PC applies for planning permission it benefits from a 50% discount on planning fees. Clerk to confirm whether this discount still applies if the PC is applying on behalf of another organisation. Malcom Groves, Chairman of Sustainable Chale invited to July's meeting to discuss further and agree next steps
  - Holiday arrangements; clerk will be away from Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June until Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> July and requested any items for July's agenda to please let her know ASAP as the agenda will need to be issued by Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June
  - The National Joint Council for Local Government Services (NJC) reached agreement on new pay scales for 2016-2017 confirming Clerk's salary increase from £17,714.26 to £17,891 as from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016. Pro rata this is an increase of £2.98 a month
  - IW Best Kept Village Awards an invitation has been received to the presentation of the 2016 awards on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2016 at 7.30pm at the Island Innovation V1 Form campus in Newport. Cllrs confirmed they will not be able to attend on this occasion, clerk to send apologies.
  - Information received from the Centenary Fields Programme about their joint
    programme delivered by the Royal British Legion and the Fields in Trust (national
    playing fields association) aiming to protect green spaces that have an existing or
    planned link to World War One, inviting local areas to nominate a recreational space
    to be dedicated as a centenary field at a cost of £50 a year. Cllrs feel the area has
    stronger connections to World War Two but clerk will pass on to Malcom Groves,
    Chale Recreation Ground for their consideration
  - Two requests for donations/grants potentially for July's agenda
    - Isle of Wight Age UK Good Neighbour scheme asked PC to consider making a small grant to enable their good neighbour scheme to continue to provide a valuable volunteering resource for the areas older residents, especially those who are most socially isolated and lonely. Cllrs requested the clerk pass this information on to Chale Village Partnership who they feel it will be more relevant for.
    - Contacted by the founder of the charity Bus Shelter IOW, requesting donations to fund the project and attend a PC meeting to discuss the project further. Clerk will invite to September's meeting.

Cllr Ron Groves reported on his visit to SWAY's Wednesday night youth group where there were 15/16 young people in attendance. They have arranged various trips and are currently looking to challenge the WI to a darts match.

Cllr Ron Groves shared communication he had had with Dave Badman regarding the possibility of opening up the access to Whale Chine.

Cllr Ron Groves suggested to the PC that in lieu of the biodiversity project coming to fruition how about planting some bulbs around the seats and signs to the village. He has plenty of daffodils, bluebells and snowdrops he can provide. Cllrs supportive and felt that they could do this between them.
